Two Juveniles Charged in Connection with Apache Junction Bullying

FLORENCE, AZ (3/25/13) - On Monday, Pinal County Attorney Lando Voyles announced two juveniles are charged in connection with Apache Junction bullying case.

Pinal County Attorney Voyles filed Assault charges against two juveniles, both Class One Misdemeanors. Both individuals charged are presumed innocent until proven guilty.

Lando Voyles released the following statement, "My focus remains fighting for safer communities, including freeing our children of school ground bullies. I remain resolved in seeking justice for all victims, including our juvenile victims."
