Pursuant to A.R.S. §11-362, this report is submitted regarding the Pinal County Attorney's Office Adult  
Deferred Prosecution (ADP) Program.

Pinal County Attorney's Office defers prosecution in cases where low risk defendants, who have been  
charged with non-violent crimes, participate in the ADP Program. During the fiscal year, July 1, 2016  
through June 30, 2017, the ADP Program was administered by Corrective Solutions. Defendants  
complete community service, pay restitution if required, report to counselors, and attend counseling  
sessions, if necessary. Defendants who successfully complete all requirements of the program will have  
their charges dismissed.
