DON'T LEAVE PETS OR KIDS IN HOT CARS

Every year, children and animals tragically die when they are left in hot cars. One death is too many, and now a new Arizona law is aiming to end hot-car deaths, allowing Good Samaritans to take action without risk of civil liability if they rescue a child or a pet from a hot car.

If you see a child or pet in a hot car and believe they are in imminent danger of physical injury or death:

1. Call 911.
2. Determine if the vehicle is locked.
 - If unlocked, open a door to enter the vehicle.
 - If locked, you may break the window.
Do not use more force than is necessary.
3. Remain with the child or pet until the authorities arrive.
